Each year, The Arc Advocacy Network's team of family and self-advocates:

- Assists nearly 13,000 families
- Assists over 4,000 self-advocates
- Presents to over 4,400 people
- Exhibits at over 100 locations
- Shares information on YouTube to over 2,000 people

The Arc Master Trust, Indiana's leading special needs trust, serving Hoosiers of all disabilities:

- Assists over 4,000 trust beneficiaries
- Processes almost 12,000 disbursements totaling \$6.7 million

Erskine Green Training Institute provides postsecondary training opportunities for people with disabilities that empower and lead to meaningful employment.

- Trains up to 80 people
- Assists graduates with an 80% postgraduation employment rate
- Connects graduates to over 100 employers

Public policy efforts ensure a full time presence at the Indiana Statehouse and in the halls of Congress.

Recent victories include:

- Achieved bi-partisan support for an \$80 million appropriation that will provide funding to boost DSP wages to an average of \$15 an hour
- Secured almost \$200 million in additional funds for special education services
- Championed legislation to prevent discrimination against Hoosier's with disabilities seeking to foster or adopt
