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# Community Integrations & Habilitation (CIH) and Family Supports Waiver (FSW) Enrollment

## **NUMBERS ENROLLED ON DDRS/BDDS WAIVERS**

- 9,638 CIH Waiver Enrollees in 2022
- 24,135 FSW Enrollees in 2022

# CIH Applications – *All categories as of 6/1/2023*

- 111 CIH applications submitted thus far in second quarter 2023 including all categories.
  - Of the 15 applications with a decision rendered, 100% have been approved.
- 186 CIH applications submitted in first quarter 2023 including all categories.
  - Of the 103 applications with a decision rendered, 84.47% have been approved.
- 185 CIH applications submitted in fourth quarter 2022 including all categories.
  - Of the 177 applications with a decision rendered, 69.49% have been approved.
- Averaging 57 CIH applications per month with 72% in the submitted in the Health and Safety category.

# CIH Applications under Emergency Placement categories as of 6/1/2023

- 97 CIH applications under Emergency Placement categories were submitted in second quarter 2023.
  - Of the 6 applications with a decision rendered, 100% have been approved.
- 128 CIH applications under Emergency Placement categories submitted in first quarter 2023.
  - Of the 51 applications with a decision rendered, 68.63% have been approved.
- Averaging 41 CIH applications under emergency placement categories per month.

# Applications for Emergency Placement – by Priority Category as of 6/1/2023

3 CIH applications under Abuse, Neglect, and Exploitation received in second quarter 2023.

- Of those reviewed and decision rendered, 100% approved.

3 CIH applications under Abuse, Neglect, and Exploitation received in first quarter 2023.

- Of those reviewed and decision rendered, 100% approved.

6 CIH applications under Caregiver over 80 received in second quarter 2023.

- Of those reviewed and decision rendered, 100% approved.

12 CIH applications under Caregiver over 80 received in first quarter 2023.

- Of those reviewed and decision rendered, 100% approved.

9 CIH applications under loss of caregiver received in second quarter 2023.

- Of those reviewed and decision rendered, 100% approved.

79 CIH applications under health and safety received in second quarter 2023.

104 CIH applications under health and safety received in first quarter 2023.

- Of those reviewed and decision rendered, 42.86% approved.

# CIH Emergency Application Status

## 2022

- 100% of CIH applications under abuse, neglect and exploitation were approved with none pending
- 100% of CIH applications under Loss of Primary Caregiver have been approved with 1 pending
- 100% of CIH application under Caregiver over 80 have been approved with 0 pending
- 428 of the 556 (77.1%) of applications received were submitted under the health and safety priority category
  - 10 (1.8%) applications remain in pending status
    - 13 applications denied since last report

## 2023

- 183 of the 225 (81.3%) of applications received were submitted under the health and safety priority category

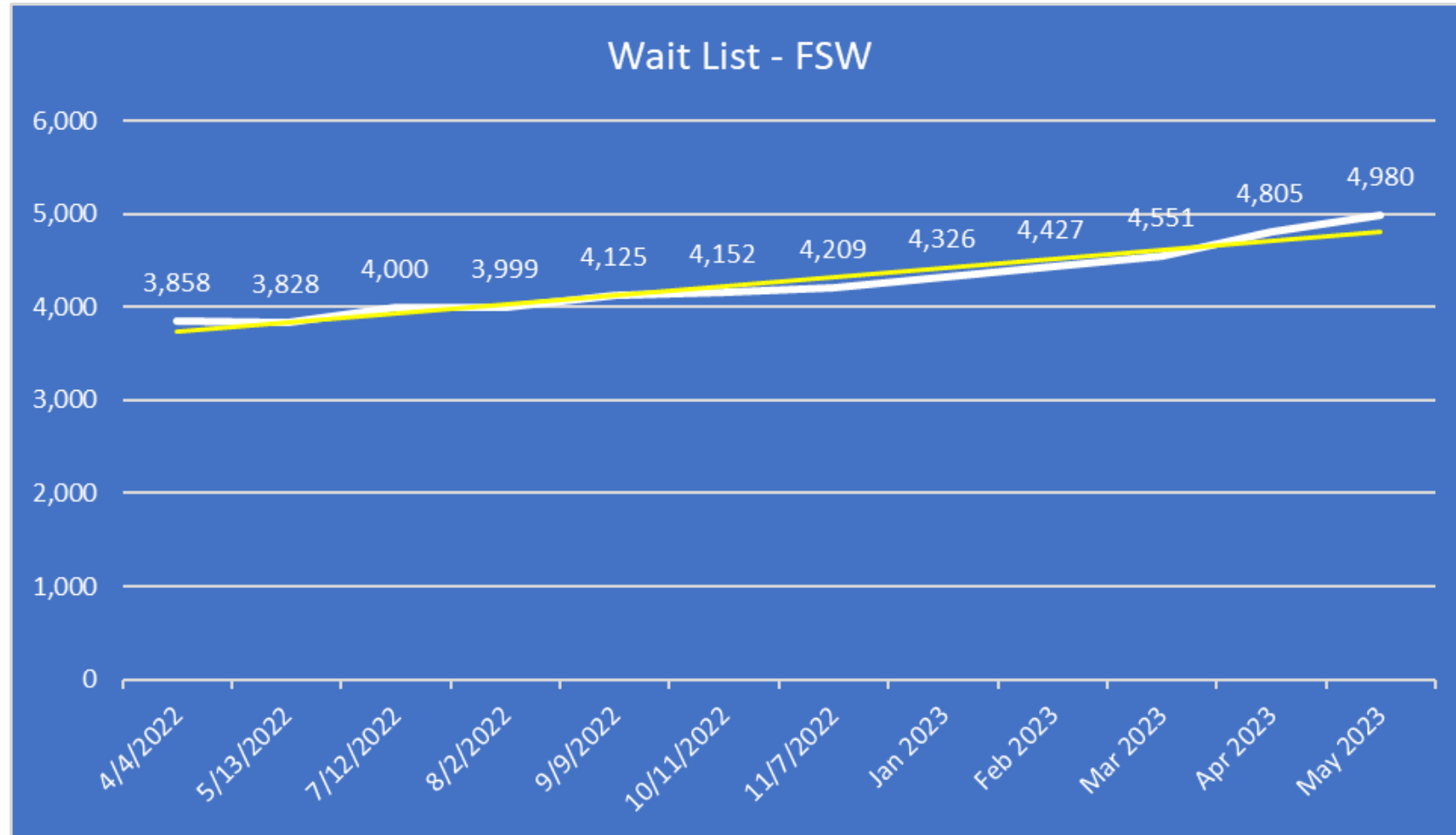
# One-Day Count of MFP- CIH Waiver as of 6/1/2023

- 47 individuals requesting MFP-CIH thus far in second quarter 2023
- May 2023 – 122 individuals on MFP-CIH
- April 2023 – 110 individuals on MFP-CIH
- In first quarter 2023, 8 individuals transitioned from MFP-CIH to CIH.
- Thus far in second quarter 2023, 20 individuals have transitioned from MFP-CIH to CIH.

# Number of Individuals on Family Supports Waiver Wait List as of 6/15/2023

- Currently inviting individuals that were added to the wait list in April 2021.
- In 2022, BDS received 7,036 applications and found 6,846 (97.30%) eligible for services.
- Most of the individuals found eligible are eventually served through the Family Support Waiver

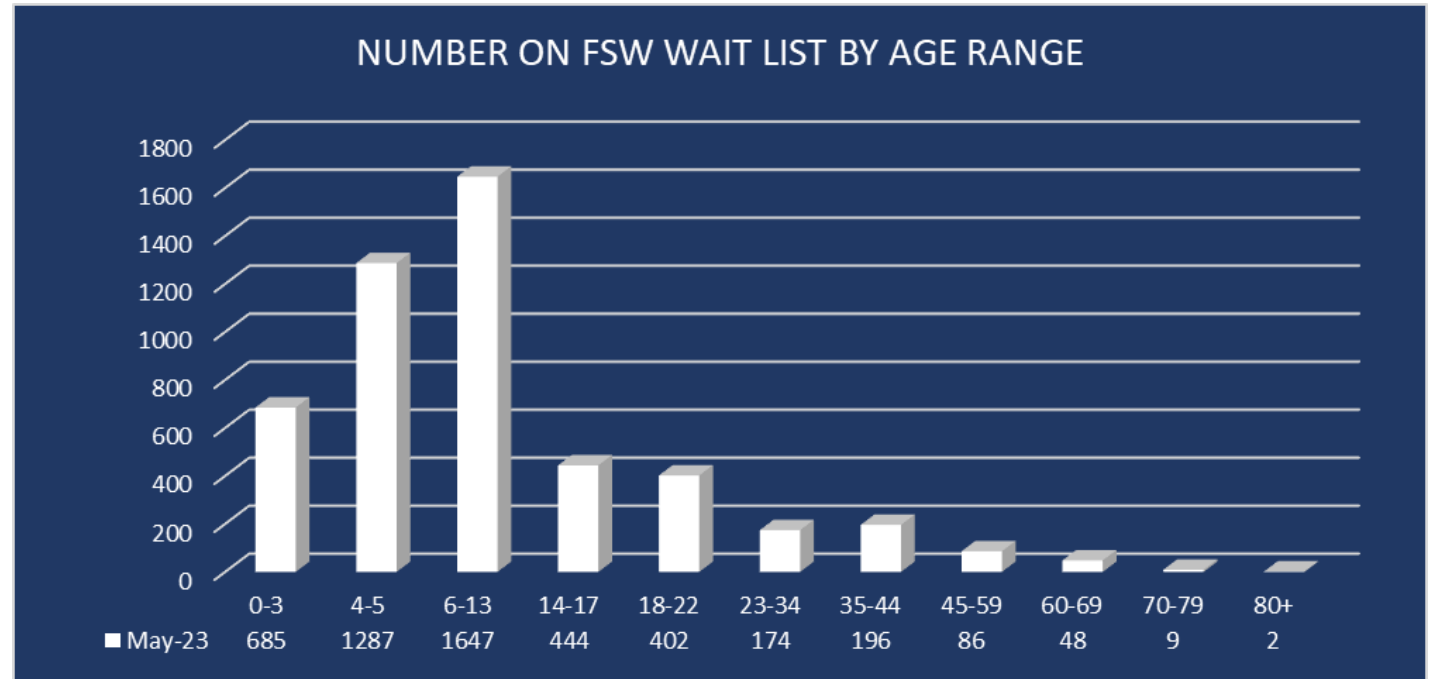

- 81.6 % of individuals on the Family Support Waiver Wait List are 17 years of age or younger.

# Supervised Group Living

- As of 6/1/2023, 2,765 individuals reside in Supervised Group Living settings
- In the SGL facilities, 24.74% of the SGL population are ages 23-34. The next highest is the age range of 45-59 with 23.65%.
- Statewide vacancy rate is 10.13% across all facilities (i.e. SGL, EMN, ESN, and CRMNF)

- In 2020, BDS received 3,555 applications for services.
- In 2021, following implementation of BDDS Gateway's on-line application, BDS received 6,546 applications for services.
- In 2022, BDS received 7,036 applications for services.
- From January 1, 2023, through May 3, 2023, BDS received 3,393 applications for services.
- Assuming applications continue at the current rate for 2023, it is anticipated that more than 8,500 BDS applications for services will be received.
- This would be a 17% increase from 2022.
